

Health and Safety Policy

Effective Health, Safety, Management control and work practice is an integral part of Accuro Environmental Limited's culture and is recognised as a key driver in respect of achieving our objectives. We are committed to meeting our legal obligations under all relevant statutory provisions and as a condition of employment we require our employees to co-operate with us to ensure we meet our objectives.

The company's Health & Safety Policy aims to address areas including:

1. Accept responsibility for the health, safety and welfare of its employees and others that may be affected by its activities.
2. Comply with all Governmental legislation, appropriate Health and Safety Regulations, Codes of Practice and Guidance Notes that establish the minimum standards of health and safety.
3. Obtain where necessary, expert advice from our Health and Safety Advisor to detect the risks to health and safety arising from Accuro Environmental's activities and the most appropriate risk control systems and workplace precautions.
4. Ensure that our management set an example in safe behaviour and effectively supervises its activities.
5. Ensure a systematic approach to the identification of risks and the allocation of resources to control them.
6. Identify, implement and maintain risk control systems and workplace precautions that meet or exceed statutory requirements including the provision and maintenance of plant and equipment that is safe to use.
7. Provide all relevant information, instruction and necessary training to its employees, in respect of risks to their health and safety, which may arise out of their work, or at their place of work.
8. Provide a fleet that is safe, road worthy, fit for purpose and comfortable for our drivers. Our drivers are aware of the hazards they face and are trained to mitigate them.
9. Make protective safety devices and equipment available to its employees and to provide instruction, information, training and supervision in their safe use.
10. Consult with employees on health and safety matters, in particular to consult with individual employees before making them responsible for health and safety.
11. Keep a constant interest in health and safety issues that are applicable to Accuro Environmental's activities.
